Are you a “sharent”?



For many children online life begins before they are even born, when their excited parents-to-be post ultrasound images on social media such as Facebook. A recent report stated that 42% of parents share photos of their children online, with half of these parents posting photos at least once a month (Ofcom, 2017).

Although the internet is a fantastic resource for parents, ensure that before you share, you give thought to exactly who can see photos and comments featuring your child, and how this online footprint might affect your child in years to come.

You should think about who's looking at your pictures. Who are you friends with on Facebook? When did you last check your privacy settings? Remember that anyone who can see a photo can also download or screenshot it, and could go on to share it.
